V. Major Works, Certificate of Appropriateness

1. A request has been made by Ms. Rachel Smith for a Certificate of Appropriateness to remove an existing glass porch and construct a new 14' x 17' screen porch on the structure located at 711 East Main Street.
2. A request has been made by Ms. Jane Buchholz for a Certificate of Appropriateness to: (1) extend a new roof over the kitchen and add a new 16' x 28' screen porch and (2) replace the existing windows with vinyl windows on the structure located at 734 West 2nd Street.

A request has been made by Ms. Doris Schneider and Mr. Jim Coke for a Certificate of Appropriateness to: (1) elevate the existing structure 4 feet and add new foundation and steps, and (2) remove existing dilapidated shed and construct a new 12' x 18' shed to match the house.
